Display a professional level of musical talent from training and experience. Preferred: working knowledge of the worship services and of church music. Be able to communicate well and in a friendly manner with the pastor, music director, church choir, and members of the congregation.

Main Responsibilities:

- Provide piano or guitar music in a professional manner for all worship services, choir practices (if pianist), seasonal or extra services, through accompanying worship songs and choir, and performing solo or special pieces.
- Provide music for weddings and funerals for additional compensation.
- Provide recorded music for online worship services or in absence.
- Assist in the selection of songs and is responsible for timely submission of selections for worship documents.
- Invest 5-10 hours per week, including personal practice. Must be available Sunday mornings for Worship and Wednesday evenings for Choir practice (if pianist).
